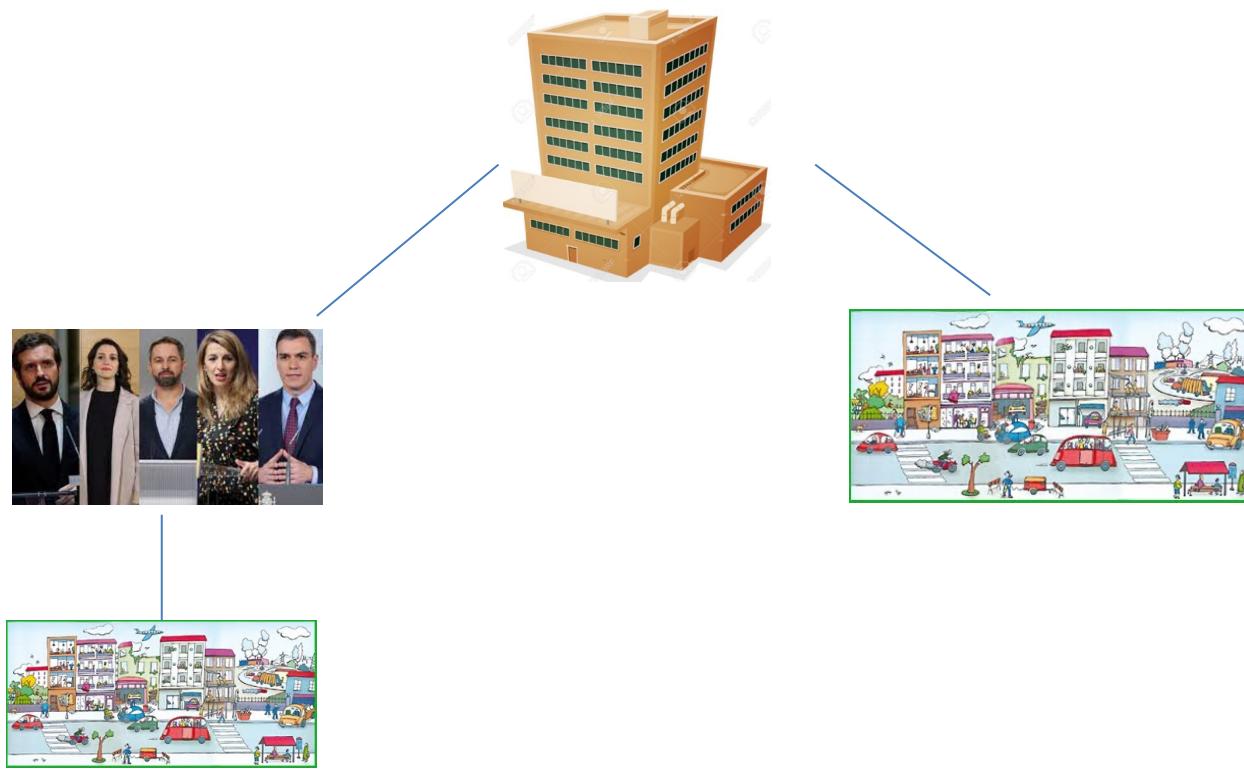

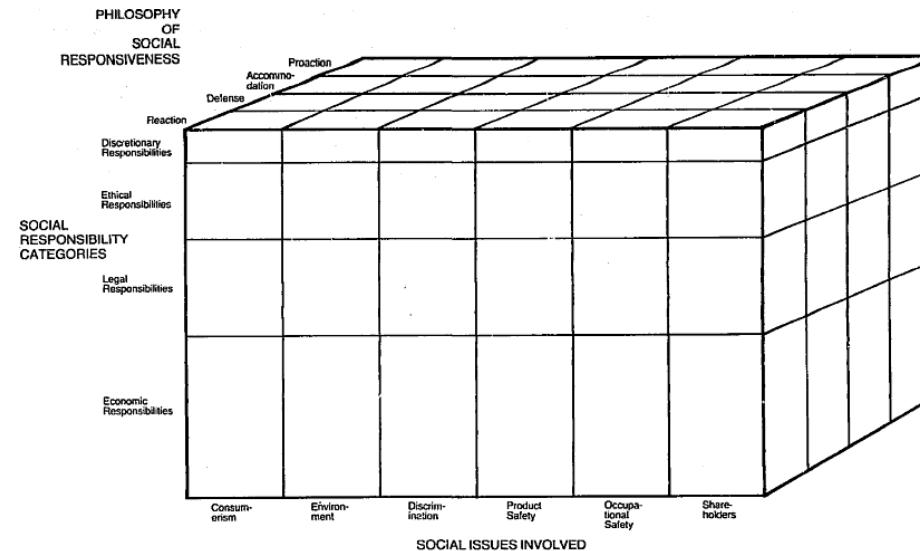

The Corporate Social Performance Model

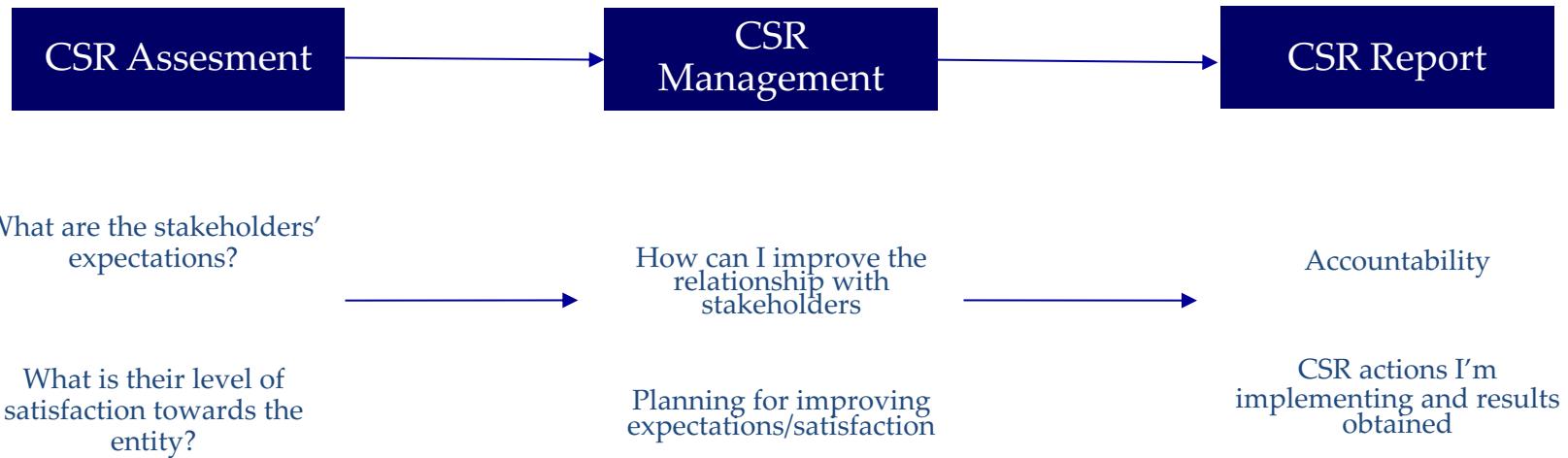

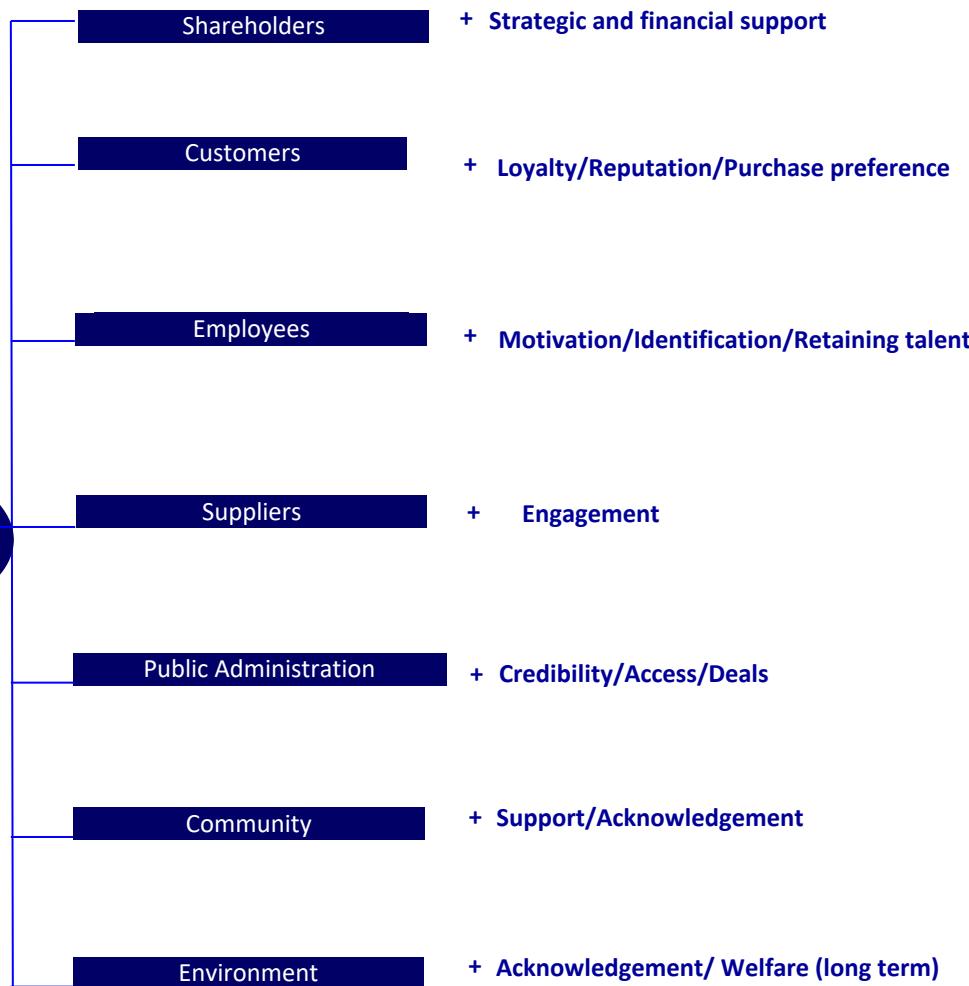

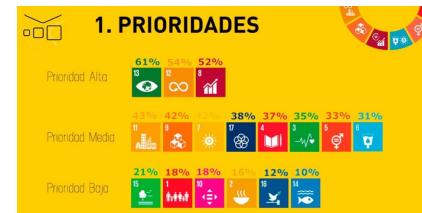

SDGs: WHAT



Sustainability means meeting the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs, ensuring a balance between economic growth, environmental care and social welfare.

Brundtland, 1987

Environmental sustainability puts the emphasis on preserving biodiversity without renouncing progress

Economic sustainability looks for present activities to be profitable without compromising the future economy

Social sustainability, intends the cohesiveness of the population and addressing future inequalities

ASG/ESG

Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) criteria are a set of rules to follow in corporate decision making. They include positive and negative criteria for evaluating in which type of assets and projects are worthwhile to **invest** in, taking into account more than just **financial criteria**.

The economic criteria is split in the financial and governance scopes.

Circular economy

Circular economy is a new model of production and consumption that ensures sustainable growth in the long-term.

Circular economy promotes resource optimization, reducing the consumption of energy and raw materials, as well as the recovery of waste by recycling them or giving them a new life cycle by turning them into new products.
